Resident Council speaking procedures

Resident Council welcomes tenants to the council meetings to speak on subjects that are important to the tenants. Speakers may address subjects not on the agenda and items the board will vote on. In order to

speak with the council during a meeting you must complete a resident speaker registration form and return to a council member before the meeting. You will not be able to speak without filling out this form.

Speakers will be limited to 2 minutes. Council will follow-up within 30 days. Please help your resident council keep order in their meetings and avoid distractions and disruptions.

Jesse Tree food box changes

If you are unable to come and pick up your box you will need to contact Resident Services department (409) 770-3015. Boxes will only be delivered to those who are physically unable to come down to pick up. Boxes will be held for those who contact Resident Services in advance with a valid reason.

You must contact Resident Services and not Resident Council.
