A Word from Management

Notice of Intent to Vacate:

Residents must give the management office notice, if he or she wishes to vacate the premises.

The Notice of Intent to Vacate form must be given to the management office 30 days prior to move out.

All leaseholders must sign the form.

Move-Out Inspection Procedures:

The resident should return the unit to its original move-in condition, less any normal wear and tear due to occupancy.

All keys, resident ID and other property of GHA must be returned at this time. Failure to return all property will result in charges
