

Provider Registration

All Home Health and Medical Providers are required to register if they are to provide in-home care for any resident residing at Gulf Breeze or Holland House.

We are asking all residents that receive in-home care to make sure that your provider is properly registered. This procedure is part of our security system and helps us protect our residents from fraud.

Each time you change your provider, you will need to complete a new form.

We will not provide photo ID's for providers. Most home health companies provide workers with some form of ID identifying the company they work for.

It is possible for your provider to be asked to identify themselves to staff or

the GPD Police Detail that provides security after hours.

If your provider has not registered or if you have a new provider, please make sure they complete a registration form.

Forms are available in the management office or they can be picked up in the resident services offices.

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Security/Resident ID Cards

There have been concerns about the absence of security guards in the buildings. All properties are being patrolled by GHA Police Detail which are officers of the Galveston Police

Department.

You may be asked by an Officer or GHA Staff to identify yourself while on GHA property. You should be able to show a GHA Resident ID card or a Texas ID or Driver's License showing your GHA address.



Proposed Amendment to Residential Lease

Amendment to GHA Residential Lease: The GHA Residential Lease – Part 2 is amended by adding the following section:

9.35. To refrain from using tobacco products inside all indoor areas of public housing, including but not limited to living units, indoor common areas, electrical closets, storage units, and GHA administrative office buildings, and in all outdoor areas within 25-feet of the housing and administrative office buildings (collectively, "Restricted Areas"). [965.653] This prohibition applies to the following tobacco products:

items that involve the ignition and burning of tobacco leaves, such as (but not limited to) cigarettes, cigars, and pipes;

waterpipes and hookahs; and

electronic nicotine delivery systems consisting of devices that provide a vapor of liquid nicotine or other substances to the user as she or he simulates smoking.

Nevertheless, the use of these tobacco products is permitted in areas visibility designated by the GHA which are located outside of Restricted Areas.

TENANT CERTIFIES AND AGREES THAT HE/SHE HAS RECEIVED, READ AND UNDERSTOOD ALL PROVISIONS OF THIS LEASE AMENDMENT AND FURTHER AGREES TO BE BOUND BY THE PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS AS WRITTEN THEREIN.
