Hurricane Season is from June 1 to
November 30. GHA in collaboration with the City of Galveston has established a comprehensive hurricane evacuation plan for residents who will need transportation off the Island in case of a severe hurricane should hit Galveston.

In addition, GHA has an agreement with Emergency Management Office to provide buses to transport the residents of the GHA to emergency shelters in Austin.

If you have not registered with the Hurricane Emergency Evacuation form, please make sure to complete a form and turn it in to the management office or with resident services.

Try to eliminate storing belongings in


cardboard boxes and discard unnecessary papers.

Galveston Island Trolley service begins Friday June 2, 2017.

The fares will be waived for summer for all riders. The service will operated seven days a week from 10 am to 10 pm.

The stops include 7 stops downtown, a ride down 25th street where riders will transfer to the Seawall trolley, and stops all along the Seawall from Stewart Beach through Moody Gardens.
