Many take


advantage of the day off with a long weekend to gather with friends and family.

warnings. Keep a list of contact information. Put together a basic disaster supply kit. When waiting out a storm be careful, the danger may not be over yet. Be alert for

tornadoes, they are often spawned by hurricanes. The calm "eye" of the storm may seem like the storm is over but after the eve passes the wind quickly returns to hurricane force.


