Hurricane Season Begins

June 1 to November 30 is Hurricane season. Peak times in this area are July to September. GHA is concerned for your safety in the event of a hurricane. If you need transportation and shelter off the island it is very important that you pick up an "Emergency **Evacuation Form**" from Management

and return it to Management or Resident Service as soon as possible. It is important that vou indicate the total number within your household, pets and any medical needs or medical equipment so that we may prepare adequate transportation and shelter for you. **Resident Service** held two

Hurricane **Preparedness** Meetings last month to allow residents the opportunity to find out procedures and to ask any questions about this process. If the City of Galveston orders a mandatory evacuation residents will be required to vacate all GHA properties.


