Counselors can help you choose between traditional Medicare and a Medicare Advantage Plan (Part C). They help with comparing prescription drug plans (Part D). They can also assist with general questions about meals,

transportation and in-home care. Assistance with food stamp application is also available. If qualified for **Extra Help** you will receive help for paying for medications, Part D premiums or co-pays.
