## **Resident Council Elections**



## **Dogs In Common Areas**

Your dog must be under effective control at all times when in the common areas. This means that the dog must be on a leash and under control of someone capable of controlling the dog. When inside the building the leash must not allow your pet to be more than one foot from you. If you fail to comply with this requirement you will get a written lease violation. Be mindful of how your dog interacts with other animals. Aggressive dogs should be handled carefully.




