# **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

## **DISPOSAL OF JESSE TREE BOXES**

Please properly dispose of your Jesse Tree Food Boxes. Once boxes are emptied, please make sure that you are breaking the boxes down and throwing them in the dumpsters. If you live at Holland House, please make sure they are thrown away in the trash rooms and not in the laundry rooms. If you live at Gulf Breeze, please make sure you are throwing your box in the dumpster and not forcing them down the trash chute. If you live in the Oaks, please make sure that you are not leaving your boxes sitting on the curb for long periods of time. Make sure they are broken down and put in your trash container.

## **UNREGISTERED VEHICLES**

Just a reminder that if your car does not have an updated registration sticker, it is subjected to being towed off GHA property. Cars must be in working order with up to date registration as well as a property sticker to be parked on the property. A car sitting on the property with a flat tire is considered to be not in working order.

# AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM MANAGEMENT

## REPORTING CHANGES

Please remember that it is your obligation to report ANY and ALL changes that happen in your household. This includes if your income goes up or down, someone moves out, or you are requesting to add someone to your household.

- When something changes, you **MUST** report your change, in writing, within ten (10) days of the occurrence.
- You will need a change form to report income changes and/or someone moving out of your household.

You will need a form from the office to request the addition of an adult member to your household.

**IMPORTANT:** Please know that completing a form to add a member to your household does not give you authorization to allow anyone to move into your unit. You **MUST** first receive Housing Authority approval before you move anyone into your unit.

## OUTSTANDING BALANCES

If you have received a call or letter from management regarding an outstanding balance, please see your building manager as soon as possible to take care of this matter.

Failure to take care of this matter may result in eviction.

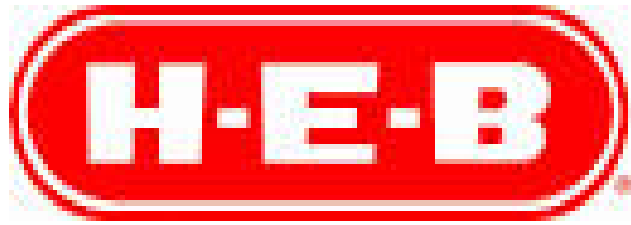

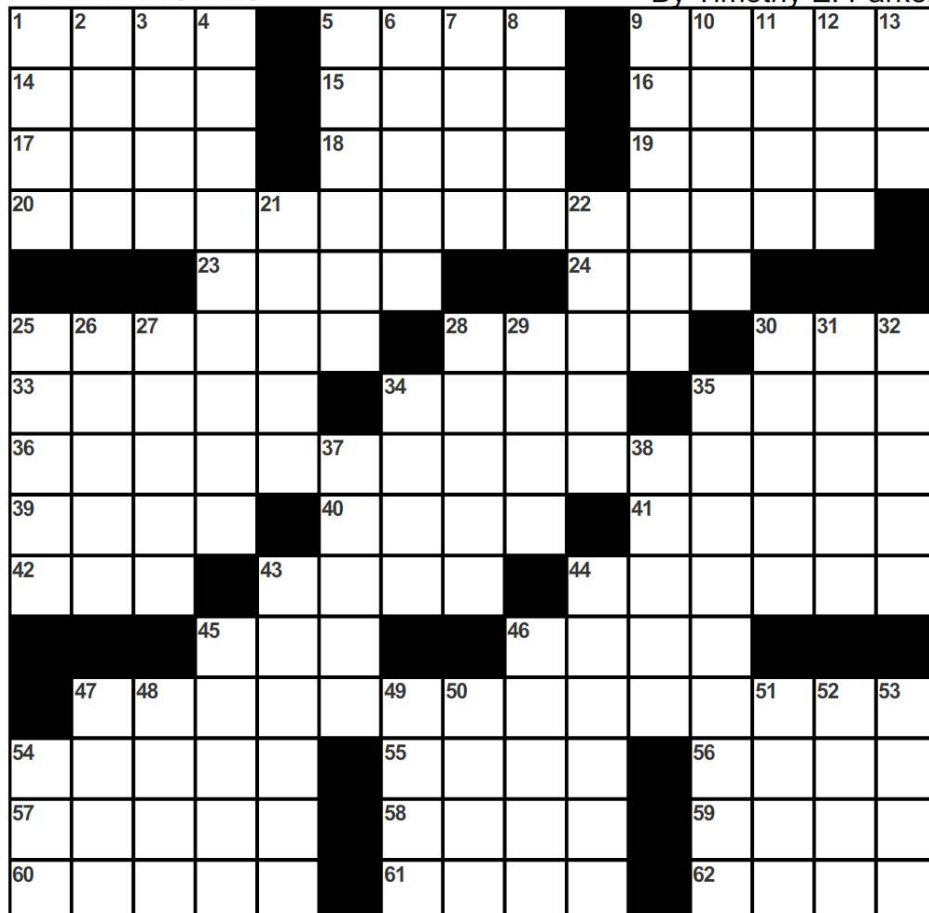
